- **4. PRIZES:** Each winner may select up to \$200 in locally produced meats from the farmer he or she indicated in the emailed entry. Entrants must choose only one (1) farm from the list of Tennessee meats producers listed on the contest page and enter that one participating farm in the space provided. Winners may receive the prize from that farm only and must travel to that farm to collect the prize. There is no cash value to the prize; if a contest winner chooses less than \$200 worth of meats, there will be no cash remainder. Contest entries will be accepted between 8 a.m. CDT on Thursday, August 12, 2021 and midnight CDT on Saturday, August 21, 2021.
- **5. WINNER NOTIFICATION:** Contest ends at midnight CDT on Saturday, August 21, 2021 and winners will be contacted on Monday, August 23, 2021. Inability to receive contact confirmation from a winner by noon CDT on Wednesday, August 25, 2021 will result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner.
